Goal 1. No Poverty

- 1.1 No one to live under \$1.25 a day
- 1.2 Halve the number of people living in poverty
- 1.3 Implement social protection systems for all
- 1.4 Ensure equal access to basic services, natural resources, finance and ownership of land for all men and women
- 1.5 Improve resilience of the poor and vulnerable to shocks and disasters
- 1.a Ensure significant mobilization of resources
- 1.b Create policies to support investment in poverty eradication actions



Goal 2. Zero Hunger

- 2.1 End hunger and ensure access to food by all
- 2.2 End all forms of malnutrition
- 2.3 Double the agricultural productivity and incomes of small-scale food producers
- 2.4 Ensure sustainable food production systems and implement resilient agricultural practices
- 2.5 Maintain the genetic diversity of seeds, plants and animals
- 2.a Increase investment in rural infrastructure, agricultural research, technology and gene banks
- 2.b Correct and prevent trade restrictions and distortions in world agricultural markets including eliminating export subsidies
- 2.c Ensure proper functioning of food commodity market and access to information to limit extreme food price volatility



Goal 3. Good Health

- 3.1 Reduce the global maternal mortality ratio
- 3.2 End preventable deaths of newborns and children under 5
- 3.3 End the epidemics of AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria and NTDs and combat communicable diseases
- 3.4 Reduce by one third premature mortality from non-communicable diseases
- 3.5 Strengthen the prevention and treatment of substance abuse
- 3.6 By 2020, halve the number of global deaths and injuries from road traffic accidents
- 3.7 Ensure universal access to sexual and reproductive health-care services
- 3.8 Achieve universal health coverage including financial protection, and access to healthcare services, medicines and vaccines
- 3.9 Substantially reduce the number of deaths and illnesses from hazardous chemicals and pollution
- 3.a Strengthen the implementation of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control
- 3.b Support R&D of vaccines and medicines and provide access to them, particularly in developing countries, in accordance with Doha Declaration
- 3.c Increase health financing and training and development of health workforce
- 3.d Strengthen capacity of all countries for management of health risks



Goal 4. Quality Education

- 4.1 Ensure all girls and boys complete free primary and secondary education
- 4.2 Ensure that all girls and boys have access to quality early childhood development, care and pre-primary education
- 4.3 Ensure equal access for all to technical, vocational and tertiary education
- 4.4 Increase the number of youths and adults who have relevant skills for employment
- 4.5 Eliminate gender disparities in education
- 4.6 Ensure all youth and substantial proportion of adults achieve literacy and numeracy
- 4.7 Ensure all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development
- 4.a Build and upgrade educational facilities that are safe, inclusive and effective environments for all
- 4.b By 2020, substantially increase the number of scholarships for higher education in developing countries
- 4.c Substantially increase supply of qualified teachers in developing countries



Goal 5. Gender Equality

- 5.1 End all forms of discrimination against all women and girls everywhere
- 5.2 Eliminate all forms of violence against all women and girls
- 5.3 Eliminate all harmful practices, such as child, early and forced marriage and female genital mutilation
- 5.4 Recognize and value unpaid care and domestic work
- 5.5 Ensure women's full and effective participation and equal opportunities for leadership
- 5.6 Ensure universal access to sexual and reproductive health and reproductive rights
- 5.a Undertake reforms to give women equal rights to economic and natural resources, financial services and ownership and control over property
- 5.b Enhance use of enabling technology to promote empowerment of women
- 5.c Adopt and strengthen policies for promotion of gender equality and empowerment of all women and girls



Goal 6. Clean Water and Sanitation

- 6.1 Achieve universal and equitable access to drinking water for all
- 6.2 Achieve access to adequate and equitable sanitation and hygiene for all and end open defecation
- 6.3 Improve water quality by reducing pollution, eliminating dumping, minimizing release of hazardous materials, halving proportion of untreated wastewater and increase recycling and reuse
- 6.4 Substantially increase water-use efficiency and reduce number of people suffering from water scarcity
- 6.5 Implement integrated water resources management
- 6.6 By 2020, protect and restore water-related ecosystems
- 6.a Expand international cooperation and capacity-building support to developing countries in water- and sanitation- related activities
- 6.b Support participation of local communities in improving water and sanitation management



Goal 7. Renewable Energy

- 7.1 Ensure universal access to affordable, reliable and modern energy services
- 7.2 Increase substantially the share of renewable energy in the global energy mix
- 7.3 Double the global rate of improvement in energy efficiency
- 7.a Enhance international cooperation to facilitate access to clean energy research and technology, and promote investment in energy infrastructure and clean energy technology
- 7.b Expand infrastructure and upgrade technology for supplying modern and sustainable energy services for all in developing countries



Goal 8. Good Jobs and Economic Growth

- 8.1 Sustain per capita economic growth in accordance with national circumstances
- 8.2 Achieve higher levels of economic productivity through diversification, technological upgrading and innovation
- 8.3 Promote development-oriented policies that support job creation, innovation and formalization and growth of enterprises
- 8.4 Improve resource efficiency in consumption and production and endeavour to decouple economic growth from environmental degradation
- 8.5 Achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men and equal pay for equal work
- 8.6 By 2020 substantially reduce the proportion of youth not in employment, education or training
- 8.7 Eradicate forced labour, end modern slavery, human trafficking and by 2025 child labour
- 8.8 Protect labour rights and promote safe and secure working environments for all
- 8.9 Implement policies to promote sustainable tourism
- 8.10 Strengthen the capacity of domestic financial institutions to expand access to financial services for all
- 8.a Increase Aid for Trade support for developing countries
- 8.b By 2020 develop and operationalize a global strategy for youth employment and implement ILO's Global Jobs Pact



Goal 9. Innovation and Infrastructure

- 9.1 Develop quality, reliable, sustainable and resilient infrastructure focussing on access for all
- 9.2 Significantly raise industry's share of employment and GDP
- 9.3 Increase access of small-scale enterprises to financial services and integration into value chains and markets
- 9.4 Make infrastructure and industries sustainable with increased resource-use efficiency and use of clean technologies
- 9.5 Enhance scientific research, upgrade the technological capabilities of industrial sectors
- 9.a Facilitate infrastructure development in developing countries through financial, technological and technical support
- 9.b Support domestic technology development, research and innovation in developing countries through policy making
- 9.c Significantly increase access to information and communications technology and by 2020 provide access to the Internet in LDCs



Goal 10. Reduced inequality

- 10.1 Achieve income growth of the bottom 40% of the population at a rate higher than the national average
- 10.2 Empower and promote the social, economic and political inclusion of all
- 10.3 Ensure equal opportunity and reduce inequalities of outcome
- 10.4 Adopt fiscal, wage and social protection policies to achieve greater equality
- 10.5 Improve the regulation and monitoring of global financial markets and institutions
- 10.6 Ensure enhanced representation and voice for developing countries in decision-making in global international economic and financial institutions
- 10.7 Facilitate orderly, safe, regular and responsible migration and mobility of people
- 10.a Implement the principle of special and differential treatment for developing countries in accordance with WTO agreements
- 10.b Encourage official development assistance and financial flows to States where it's needed the most
- 10.c Reduce to less than 3% the transaction costs of migrant remittances and eliminate remittance corridors with costs higher than 5%



Goal 11. Sustainable Cities and Communities

- 11.1 Ensure access for all to adequate, safe and affordable housing and basic services
- 11.2 Provide access to safe, affordable, accessible and sustainable transport systems for all
- 11.3 Enhance inclusive and sustainable urbanization
- 11.4 Strengthen efforts to protect and safeguard the world's cultural and natural heritage
- 11.5 Significantly reduce the number of deaths, people affected and economic losses caused by disasters
- 11.6 Reduce the adverse per capita environmental impact of cities
- 11.7 Provide universal access to safe, inclusive and accessible, green and public spaces
- 11.a Support positive economic, social and environmental links between urban, peri-urban and rural areas through development planning
- 11.b By 2020, implement policies towards climate change management, resilience to disasters and implement disaster risk management
- 11.c Support LDCs, in utilizing local materials for sustainable and resilient buildings, through financial and technical assistance



Goal 12. Responsible Consumption

- 12.1 Implement the 10-year framework of programmes on sustainable consumption and production
- 12.2 Achieve the sustainable management and efficient use of natural resources
- 12.3 Halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels
- 12.4 By 2020, achieve the environmentally sound management of chemicals and all wastes
- 12.5 Substantially reduce waste generation through prevention, reduction, recycling and reuse
- 12.6 Encourage companies to adopt sustainable practices and to integrate sustainability information into their reporting cycle
- 12.7 Promote sustainable public procurement practices
- 12.8 Ensure that people everywhere have the relevant information for sustainable development and lifestyles in harmony with nature
- 12.a Support developing countries to strengthen their scientific and technological capacity
- 12.b Develop and implement tools to monitor sustainable development impacts for sustainable tourism
- 12.c Phase out inefficient fossil-fuel subsidies while minimizing adverse impact on development



Goal 13. Climate Action

- 13.1 Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards and natural disasters
- 13.2 Integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies and planning
- 13.3 Improve education, awareness-raising and capacity on climate change management
- 13.a Mobilize jointly \$100 billion annually by 2020 to support developing countries' mitigation actions and operationalize the Green Climate Fund.
- 13.b Promote mechanisms for raising capacity for effective climate change-related planning and management in LDCs



Goal 14. Life below Water

- 14.1 By 2025, prevent and significantly reduce marine pollution
- 14.2 By 2020, sustainably manage and protect marine and coastal ecosystems
- 14.3 Minimize and address the impacts of ocean acidification
- 14.4 BY 2020, regulate harvesting and end overfishing, illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing and destructive fishing practices
- 14.5 By 2020, conserve at least 10 per cent of coastal and marine areas
- 14.6 By 2020, rationalise harmful forms of fisheries subsidies
- 14.7 Increase the economic benefits of sustainable use of marine resources to Small Island developing States and LDCs
- 14.a Increase scientific knowledge, research capacity and transfer marine technology
- 14.b Provide access for small-scale artisanal fishers to marine resources and markets
- 14.c Enhance the conservation and sustainable use of oceans by implementing international law reflected in UNCLOS



Goal 15. Life on Land

- 15.1 By 2020, ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial and inland freshwater ecosystems
- 15.2 By 2020, promote sustainable management of forests, halt deforestation, increase afforestation and reforestation
- 15.3 Combat desertification and strive to achieve a land degradation-neutral world
- 15.4 Ensure the conservation of mountain ecosystems
- 15.5 Reduce the degradation of natural habitats, halt the loss of biodiversity and by 2020 protect and prevent the extinction of threatened species
- 15.6 Ensure fair and equitable sharing of the benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources
- 15.7 End poaching and trafficking of protected species of flora and fauna
- 15.8 By 2020, prevent the introduction and significantly reduce the impact of invasive alien species
- 15.9 By 2020, integrate ecosystem and biodiversity values into national and local planning
- 15.a Mobilize and increase financial resources to conserve and sustainably use biodiversity and ecosystems
- 15.b Mobilize resources to finance sustainable forest management and provide adequate incentives to developing countries to advance such management
- 15.c Enhance global support for efforts to combat poaching and trafficking of protected species, including by increasing the capacity of local communities to pursue sustainable livelihood opportunities



Goal 16. Peace and Justice

- 16.1 Significantly reduce all forms of violence and related death rates everywhere
- 16.2 End abuse, exploitation, trafficking, violence against and torture of children
- 16.3 Promote the rule of law at the national and international levels and ensure equal access to justice for all
- 16.4 Significantly reduce illicit financial and arms flows, strengthen the recovery and return of stolen assets and combat all forms of organized crime
- 16.5 Substantially reduce corruption and bribery in all their forms
- 16.6 Develop effective, accountable and transparent institutions at all levels
- 16.7 Ensure responsive, inclusive, participatory and representative decision-making at all levels
- 16.8 Broaden and strengthen the participation of developing countries in the institutions of global governance
- 16.9 Provide legal identity for all, including birth registration
- 16.10 Ensure public access to information and protect fundamental freedoms
- 16.a Strengthen relevant national institutions, including through international cooperation, for building capacity to prevent violence and combat terrorism and crime
