Climate Peer Learning Group 2024

The purpose of this group is to provide a forum for companies with advanced knowledge of climate action and emissions reductions strategies to discuss ongoing challenges and solutions related to net zero and decarbonisation. This group is for organisations that have set science-based targets and/or developed strategies and policies for reducing Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions, but are experiencing key obstacles or barriers to achieving their goals. Topics covered in this group may include:

- Supplier engagement: how businesses are collaborating with suppliers and other stakeholders to reduce Scope 3 emissions across their value chain.
- Data: how companies are collecting, managing, and disclosing their emissions data, and what they are doing to improve the quality and robustness.
- Innovation: how companies are finding innovative solutions for reducing emissions, including utilising AI, nature-based solutions, and other business models (circular products/services, green technologies) to do this.
- Policy engagement and partnerships: how businesses are involved in collective action, lobbying, and policy engagement around legislation and finance that will support them to reach their net zero targets.

The content of this group is focused on **peer-learning**, so members will be encouraged to share as much information on their challenges, successes, ways of working, etc. as they feel comfortable doing. Members will be asked to give presentations where appropriate, but most of the group activity will be focused on facilitated conversations, sharing, learning, and collective problem solving. **For this reason, members should commit to attending every meeting and must be actively engaged and willing to partake in discussions.** From these conversations and member feedback, it will then be our aim to tailor the topics and expert input to support specific challenges, as well as schedule issue-specific ad hoc meetings where necessary. The meetings may be in-person (hybrid) or online and will be held under Chatham House Rule. Recordings will not be shared.

As an additional optional opportunity, members of this group may be invited to attend the annual UN Global Compact European Peer Learning Group on Climate, which convenes representatives from some of the largest companies in 14 countries across Europe.
